Licences, insurance & safety
□ VBA builder registration (record number noted)
☐ Public liability & WorkCover certificates sighted
$\square$ Site safety plan (OH&S), induction and supervision details provided
Experience & portfolio
☐ 3–5 recent Melbourne renovations similar to my scope (kitchen/bathroom/extension/structural)
☐ Suburb experience (e.g., inner-city access, Bayside corrosion, Peninsula winds)
☐ References provided and contactable
Design & approvals
☐ Concept design and architectural drafting available (2D/3D)
☐ Guidance on planning permits (if required) vs building permits
$\hfill \square$ Engineering, energy report, and certifier coordination included or supported
Quotes & inclusions
$\square$ Detailed scope of works with product specifications
☐ Allowances listed (appliances, tapware, tiles, lighting, landscaping)
$\square$ Exclusions identified (e.g., window furnishings, loose furniture, utility fees)
Timeline & site management
☐ Target start window and build duration provided
☐ Weekly updates / milestone calendar outlined

$\square$ Site protection, dust control, rubbish & recycling plan documented
$\square$ Live-in renovation strategy offered (if staying in the home)
Variations & communication
$\square$ Written variation process with cost/time impact approval before changes
☐ Single point of contact & response time commitments
Warranty & aftercare
☐ Defects liability period specified
☐ Product and manufacturer warranty handling clarified
☐ Post-handover check-ins scheduled
Keep a simple scoring column (1–5) beside each section to compare companies objectively.
